
NEW ADVISORY GROUP FOR RE-OPENING

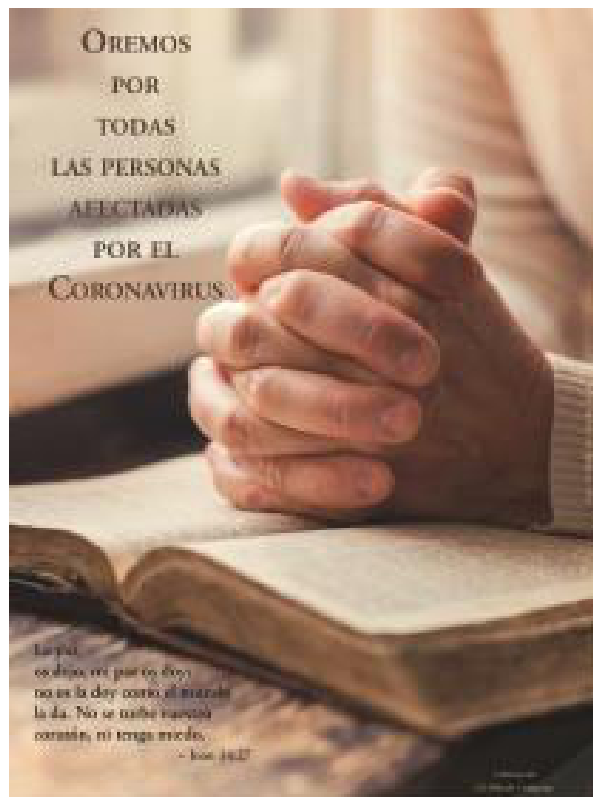

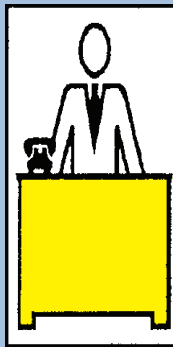
