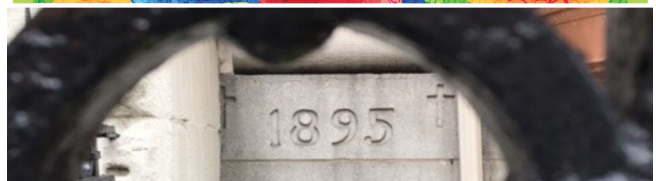

**Monday, Jan 20** our nation remembers the life and work of Dr Martin Luther King, jr. and his work for peace and justice. 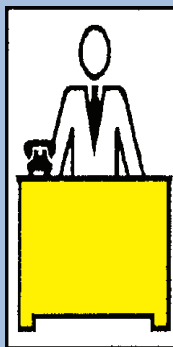
