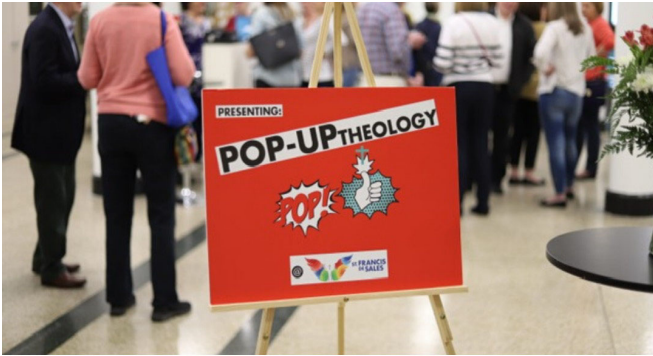

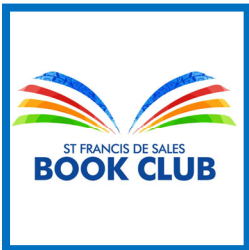

HOSPITALITY HELP NEEDED

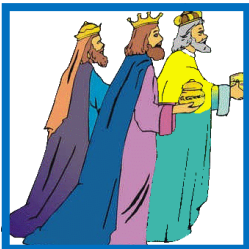

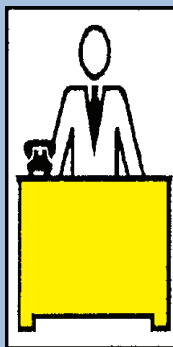
