As the Archdiocese continues to discern the safest and most practical way to open, we will keep you informed as to what stage we are at. In this digital age, we encourage you to avail yourself of the most up-to-date technology so that you are well informed. 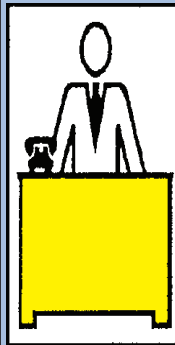

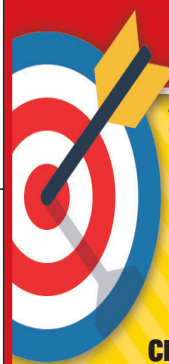
