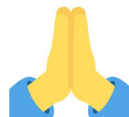
SFDS is moving over to Tithely, and we will discontinue our use of WeShare over the next few weeks.

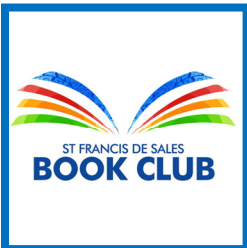

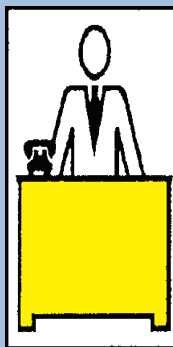
