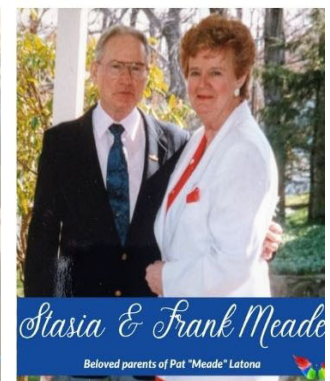
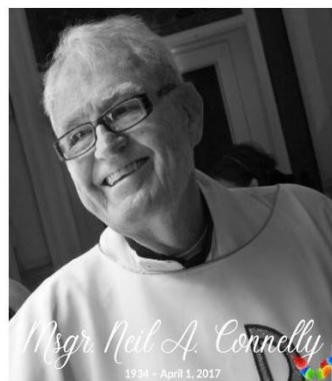
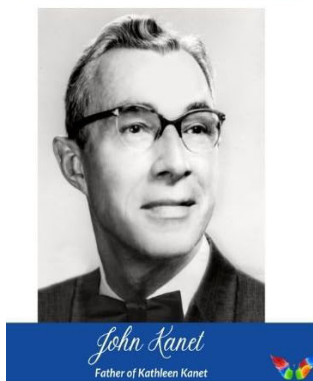
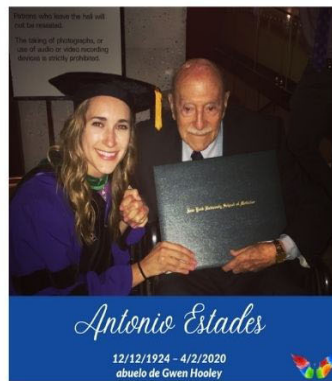
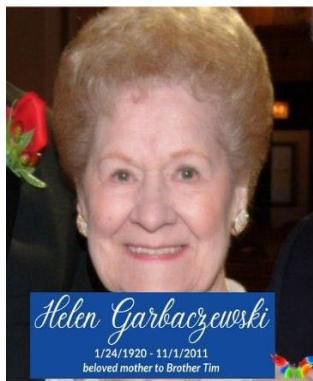
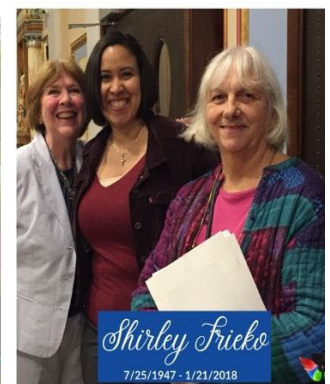
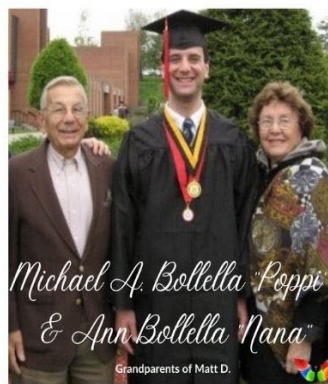
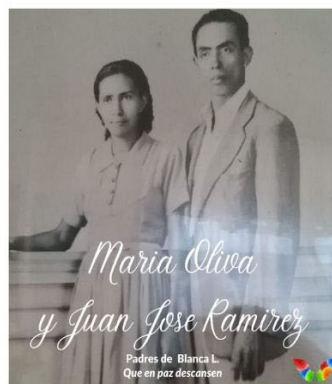
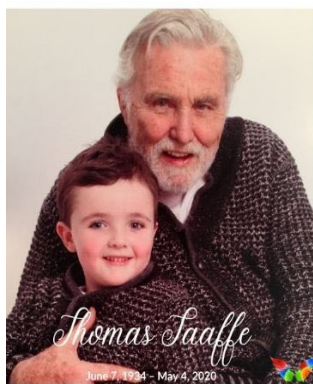


# DIGITAL ALTAR OF REMEMBRANCE

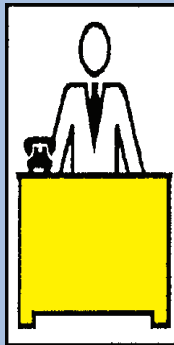
