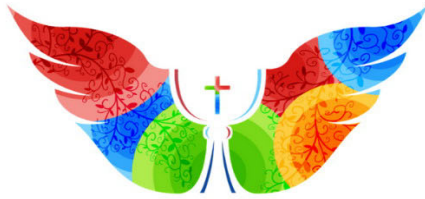

Election Day is Tuesday, November 3, 2020

Early Voting Period is October 24, 2020 - November 1, 2020

You can vote even if you cannot get to the polling place on Election Day.

### When is it due?

You must postmark, apply online, email, or fax completed application for the General Absentee ballot by **October 27, 2020**.

You may apply in-person by **November 2, 2020**. Ballots will be mailed beginning on/after **September 18, 2020**.

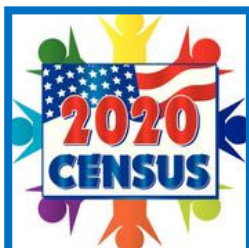

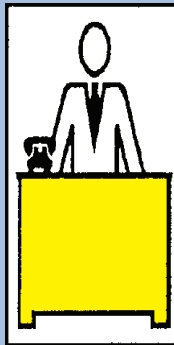

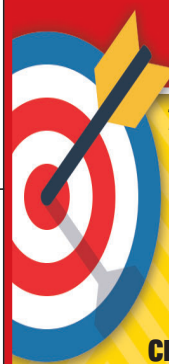
