Our role is to recognize that the initiation of adults is the responsibility of all the baptized. (that's us!) We are to give help to those who are searching for Christ. We are to be an example of faith in our words and deeds. We are to welcome candidates into our community gatherings, our homes and our conversations! We are, at the very least, to keep our candidates in our prayers as they prepare for the reception of their sacraments. (RCIA #9) OUR ROLE in this process is this: to be an EXAMPLE of FAITH! And so we ask you as the people of St Francis de Sales: how will you do this as we enter into a new year? Come to a Monday night meeting and bring some cupcakes! Take a moment to talk with one of our candidates before or after Sunday Mass downstairs.

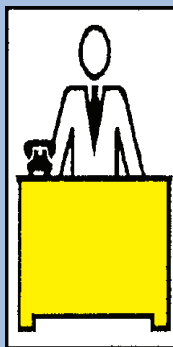
