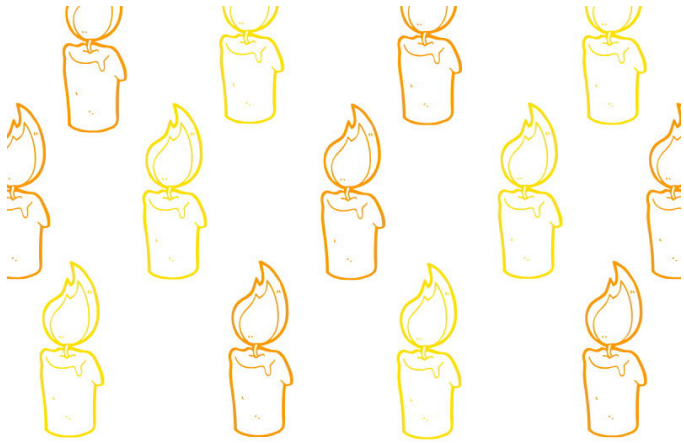

## RCIA "24-7"

You hear us mention "RCIA or Initiation Ministry often enough here at St. Francis but do you actually know What YOUR role in this process of initiation is? Currently we have quite a group of folks (9) asking questions About what it means to live a Catholic life, who we are as church and how they might go about joining us in Our faith journey. Their curiosity is a blessing to us as a parish. We welcome inquirers any day, anytime.

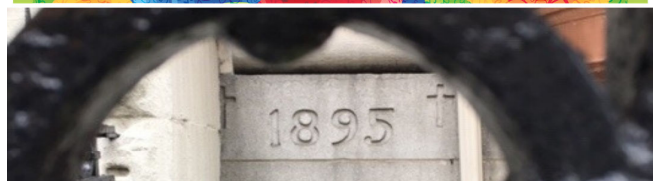

## MARDI GRAS

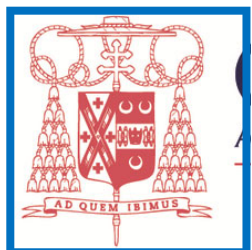

## BECAUSE IT'S FLU SEASON...

It has come to our attention that we are deep into the midst of flu season. As we recognize how easy it is to spread germs we don't even realize we have, we have made the decision, that for the time being, we will only offer Eucharist under the one species. When flu season is safely behind us, we will return to our practice of offering communion under both species. As a reminder, as Catholics we teach and believe that the fullness of our Lord Jesus, body and blood, is fully present in both the bread and wine individually. In limiting the reception of communion from the chalice we are simply practicing a most cautious approach to communion during these winter days.

## MARDI GRAS

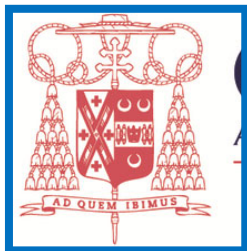

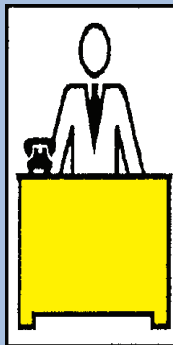
