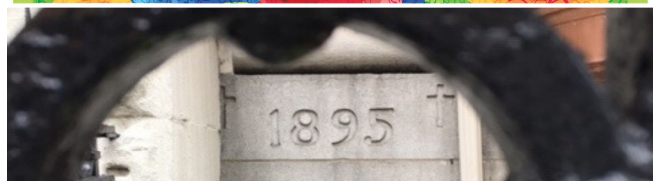

## BAPTISMS

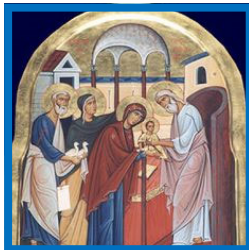

## SOLICITUD DE EMERGENCIA-RESPUESTA NECESARIA!

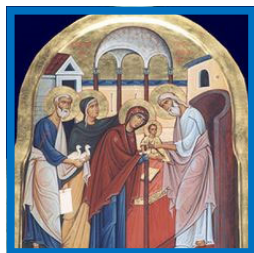

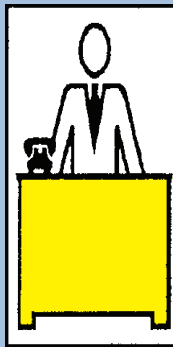
