As the Archdiocese continues to discern the safest and most practical way to open, we will keep you informed as to what stage we are at. The best and most up-to-date information will continue to be on our web page, www.sfdsnyc.org and in our other social media platforms. In this digital age, we encourage you to avail yourself of the most up-to-date technology so that you are well informed. As we move toward a "new normal" we ask that you seriously consider using electronic giving as your preferred means of support. 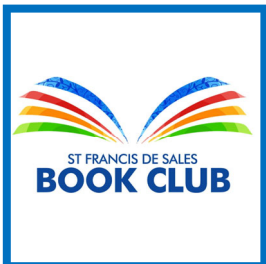
ARE YOU QUESTIONING?

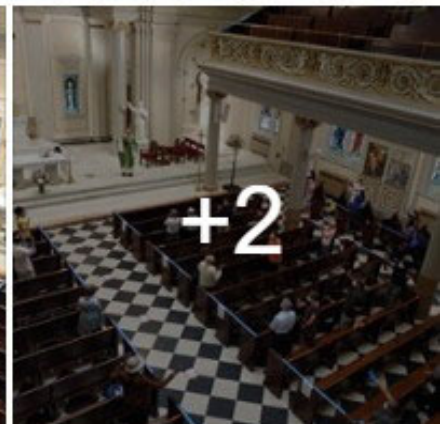

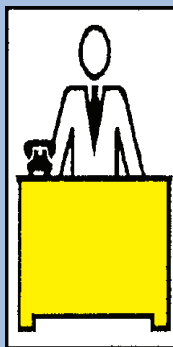
