During Lent, we turn away from habits that diminish our spirits, and instead turn towards the selfless love Christ offers us. The Catholic tradition of eating plant-based meals every Friday during lent is a small step towards growing in humility and simplicity. What's more, it's a way of living more sustainably in our common home. Eating meat in itself is not a bad thing, but our over consumption of meat means greater demands on forestland and water and rising greenhouse gas emissions. For instance, cattle ranching accounts for approximately 80% of deforestation in Brazil. To protect creation and those who share it, **consider at least one meatless day every week**. This helps us grow in simplicity and protects our common home.



WHAT ARE YOU THINKING ABOUT FOR LENT?

St Francis de Sales Parish invites you and your family to think about 'giving up' some screen time this Lent and replacing that with actual FACETIME with your family and other families in our parish. We believe that good spiritual and psychological practice go hand in hand. To that end, we want to support our families in their efforts to teach our children about Lenten sacrifice. Sacrifice during Lent is designed to help us discover what God desires for us. It is our hope that by purposely choosing GAME DAY FACE TIME over screentime, families will rediscover the joy of quality time with one another. By coming together around a game, families will be placing priority on their time together. 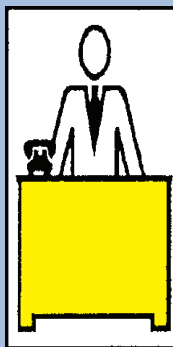
