And Speaking of Community Needs: We received this request for help from a colleague of ours in the Episcopal Church in Brooklyn. If you can send these needed items to St Philip's Church in Brooklyn, they would be much appreciated! The deadline is Nov. 15th.

I'm on a mission! A mission to bring dignity and critical assistance to girls and women acutely affected in pandemic. My mission is period products. And I'm writing now to ask for your support.

It started when the schools closed. A woman on the street sheepishly begged me for tampons. They were for her young daughter who usually gets them at school. And then I was approached again. And again. Gut-wrenching appeals for items of basic dignity, necessity, and comfort. Tampons allow women to participate without limit in school, work, childcare, sports, and recreation. Some basic statistics:

The average woman (girl) has 13 periods per year at an annual cost of \$75.
Period products are not covered by public assistance such as WIC and SNAP.
25% of NYC girls live in poverty and rely on their schools for these essential items. Schools are legally required to supply tampons and other period products.

- Tampons and pads are taxed by most states while other essentials are not.
- Period products are usually unavailable at social service organizations due to high demand and low donations.

We're partnered locally with Reaching Out Community Services to provide tampons in coordination with their Thanksgiving outreach effort to nearly 600 families. This is a unique opportunity to serve South Brooklyn women and girls. Please join us by helping in one of three ways:

TO MEMBERS OF THE CHURCH OF SAINT FRANCIS DE SALES PARISH COMMUNITY

The health and safety of the parish staff and community at the Church of Saint Francis de Sales is our top priority. We want to inform you that a volunteer from our 12:30pm Sunday Mass self-reported a positive test result for COVID-19. **The last day of exposures was Sunday, October 25, 2020.** CDC advises that any symptoms of Coronavirus appear between 2 and 14 days from the date of exposure. We are handling this situation with the utmost seriousness. It is important to listen to facts and not respond to fear or rumor. We would encourage you to visit the CDC web-site www.CDC.Gov for additional factual information.

The parish is following protocols from the CDC and NYS DOH and has conducted cleaning of the affected spaces at the parish in compliance with CDC Guidelines using approved disinfectants.

The NYS Department of Health has advised that only those individuals who were in “close contact” with the infected person are required to quarantine. Individuals who were in close contact are persons who were within 6 feet of the infected individual for ten minutes or more. The parish will be contacting those individuals today who have been identified as potentially being in close contact with the infected individual to alert them to the situation. The New York City Health Department will then contact these individuals to initiate contact tracing, if necessary.

Because we have followed all guidelines on social distancing and wearing personal protective items, the likelihood of anyone becoming infected from this positive case is low. However, if you develop or have developed COVID-19 symptoms, you should call your medical professional or you can call the **ArchCare COVID-19 Hotline at 1-877-239-1998**. Archcare has allocated staff to handle inquiries and provide guidance to members of the Archdiocesan community, including clergy, religious, volunteers, lay personnel, students, and their families. The Archcare Intake Specialists will answer all questions or route you to someone who can address your concerns. Archcare can also provide you with information about obtaining a COVID-19 test to determine if you have been infected by the virus.

The New York State Department of Health has set up a hotline at (888) 364-3065 where Department of Health experts will be available to answer questions regarding COVID-19. People inquiring about testing can call 1-888-364-3065.

During times like this, the safety and well-being of our Catholic parish families, staff, and those in our care, as well as those in the broader community around us, are our primary concern.

A LOS MIEMBROS DE LA COMUNIDAD PARROQUIAL DE LA IGLESIA DE SAN FRANCISCO DE SALES

La salud y seguridad del personal de la parroquia y de la comunidad en la Iglesia de San Francisco de Sales es nuestra máxima prioridad. Queremos informarle que un voluntario de nuestra misa dominical de las 12:30pm nos informó de un resultado positivo para COVID-19. **El último día de exposiciones fue el domingo 25 de octubre de 2020.** Los Centros para el Control y la Prevención de Enfermedades (CDC) aconsejan que cualquier síntoma de Coronavirus aparezca entre 2 y 14 días a partir de la fecha de exposición. Estamos manejando esta situación con la mayor seriedad. Es importante escuchar los hechos y no responder al miedo o al rumor. Le recomendamos que visite el sitio web de los CDC www.CDC.Gov/spanish para obtener información fáctica adicional.

La parroquia está siguiendo los protocolos de los CDC y el Departamento de Salud del Estado de Nueva York y ha llevado a cabo la limpieza de los espacios afectados en la parroquia en cumplimiento con las pautas de los CDC utilizando desinfectantes aprobados.

El Departamento de Salud del Estado de Nueva York ha advertido que solo aquellas personas que estaban en “contacto cercano” con la persona infectada están obligadas a poner en cuarentena. Las personas que estuvieron en contacto cercano son personas que estuvieron a menos de 6 pies del individuo infectado durante diez minutos o más. La parroquia se pondrá en contacto con las personas que han sido identificadas como potencialmente en contacto cercano con la persona infectada para alertarles de la situación. El Departamento de Salud de la Ciudad de Nueva York se pondrá en contacto con estas personas para iniciar el rastreo de contactos, si es necesario.

Debido a que hemos seguido todas las pautas sobre distanciamiento social y uso de elementos de protección personal, la probabilidad de que alguien se infecte por este caso positivo es baja. Sin embargo, si usted desarrolla o ha desarrollado síntomas de COVID-19, debe llamar a su profesional médico o puede llamar a la **Línea Directa ArchCare COVID-19 al 1-877-239-1998**. Archcare ha asignado personal para manejar consultas y proporcionar orientación a los miembros de la comunidad arquidiocesana, incluyendo clérigos, religiosos, voluntarios, personal laico, estudiantes, y sus familias. Los especialistas en admisión de Archcare responderán a todas las preguntas o lo dirigirán a alguien que pueda abordar sus preocupaciones. Archcare también puede proporcionarle información sobre cómo obtener una prueba COVID-19 para determinar si ha sido infectado por el virus.

El Departamento de Salud del Estado de Nueva York ha establecido una línea directa al (888) 364-3065 donde expertos del Departamento de Salud estarán disponibles para responder a preguntas sobre COVID-19. Las personas que preguntan acerca de pruebas pueden llamar al 1-888-364-3065.

En momentos como este, la seguridad y el bienestar de nuestras familias parroquiales católicas, el personal, y los que están a nuestro cuidado, así como de los de la comunidad en general que nos rodea, son nuestra principal preocupación.

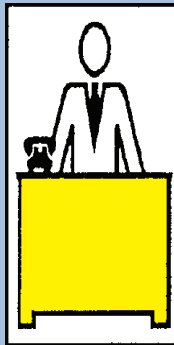
